
As a Class IV composting facility, you must maintain compliance with all applicable provisions of Chapters 3745-27 of the Ohio Administrative Code (OAC).

In accordance with OAC Rule 3745-27-40, Class IV composting facilities are facilities that:

- (1) (a) Accept only source-separated yard waste;
- (b) May utilize the following source-separated bulking agents: wood chips, straw, shredded newspaper, shredded cardboard, sawdust, shredded brush, biodegradable containers and/or stover. Such bulking agents may be commingled;
- (c) May utilize additives limited to urea and bacterial or fungal inoculum;
- (2) Are subject to the requirements of OAC Rules 3745-27-40, 3745-27-41, 3745-27-45 and 3745-27-47; and
- (3) Are exempt from the solid waste disposal fees and licensing requirements of OAC Chapters 3745-28 and 3745-37.

Prior to the date on which source separated yard wastes will be accepted, new class IV composting facilities shall submit a registration form to the Director of the Ohio EPA and a copy to the approved health district having jurisdiction. It is the applicant's responsibility to notify entities found in OAC Rule 3745-27-41(G). A registration will not be considered complete unless all the required information and original signatures, as stated in OAC Rule 3745-27-41, are submitted to the OEPA. Location certification statement must be notarized by a notary public. Only original signatures will be processed, facsimiles of signatures cannot be accepted. Please type or legibly print all required information. No registration fee is required. 2. In the case of a partnership, by a general partner; or
3. In the case of sole proprietorship, by the proprietor; or
4. In the case of a municipal, state, federal, or other government premise, by the principal executive officer, the ranking elected official, or another duly authorized employee.

The registrant understands that the Director of the Ohio EPA, or an authorized representative, upon presentation of credentials shall be allowed to:

1. Inspect at reasonable times any facilities, equipment (including monitoring and control equipment), practices, operations, or vehicles regulated or required in accordance with Chapter 3734. of the Ohio Revised Code and rules promulgated thereunder.
2. Have access to and copy, at any reasonable time, any records that must be kept in accordance with Chapter 3734. of the Ohio Revised Code and rules promulgated thereunder.
